Types of lube

- Water-based
- Silicone-based
- Hybrid
- Natural oils
- Saliva

Water-based lubes

Pros

- Historically, the most popular and most versatile
- Safe for toys and condoms
- Water soluble so easily washed away
- Available in flavors!
- Comes as liquids, gels, or creams

Cons

- They dry quickly and become sticky
- Don't work as well if you're having sex in water (e.g., shower or spa)

Popular brands

• K-Y Jelly, Astroglide, System Jo, Pjur

Silicone-based lubes

Pros

- They are the most slippery and remain so for a much longer period of time
- Ideal for non-vaginal sexual activities
- Don't degrade latex condoms
- Work well in water
- Usually not irritating b/c most free from glycols and glycerine

Cons

- Will damage silicone sex toys
- Popular brands
 - Wet, System Jo, überlube, Swiss Navy, Astroglide

Hybrid-lubes

Pros

- Easier to clean off (mostly water-based)
- Reactivates with water if it seems a little dry
- Longer lasting than plain water-based due to the silicone
 - System Jo Hybrid uses coconut oil in place of silicone
- Generally safe with silicone toys (but test first!)

Natural lubes

Pros

For people who desire to avoid unnatural ingredients

Cons

- Some oils, such as coconut oil, can damage condoms resulting in unplanned pregnancy
- Some, such as aloe vera, can cause painful irritation to skin and vaginal tissues
- Spit seen in tons of porn films. Just about everything works better than this.

Flavored Lubes

- While lube is your organ's best friend, flavored lube is your mouth's best friend.
- Unflavored lube is perfectly adequate for plain ol' "vanilla" sex.
 - However, flavored lubes can greatly enhance oral sex activities as we tend to use our tongues differently/more "intently" when a flavor is involved. These leads to a heightened sexual experience for the receiving partner.
 - Also, flavors may make the oral experience more "tolerable" for the tongue's owner under some circumstances.
